new system, so we need to activate your portal individually. To do so, contact <u>communications@daedalians.org</u> with your request for a member ID and password.

Name Tags (Repeat): If you are a new member, the flight will order you a Daedalian nametag. If you are in need of a replacement nametag, they are available through A-1 Engravers/Advanced Graphics (8800 Broadway, San Antonio. TX 78217). These are pine green tags with gold emblem and text. The larger tag, bearing your name and a replica of the Daedalian crest, is usually worn alone. They can be provided with a clutch back (2 pins) or with a magnetic back.
