### STANDARD DEBRIEF ITEMS: PREVIOUS FLIGHT LEG (19 Mar 2024): Our March

meeting was a dinner meeting in the Daedalian Room at the WPAFB Club on 19 March. After a buffet dinner and a future business update, we received a presentation from Flight 9 member Lt Gen (ret) Jack Hudson on the two-seat A-10 Single Seat Night Attack (SSNA). This program evaluated the pilot workload incurred during the performance of representative SSNA operations and addressed operational issues concerning the low-level SSNA mission. The flight test program was conducted in 1982-1983 at Edwards AFB and McChord AFB. The lessons learned have contributed greatly to the Air Force's night attack capability.

<u>Air Camp – Help Needed (Repeat):</u> We received the following from Flight member Dick Reynolds on behalf of Air Camp. :

Air Camp is presently recruiting volunteers to cover the Quest For exercises for the 2024 Air Camp season. Since inception in 2010, the Air Camp curriculum—for student camps as well as Teachers Air Camp sessions—has included a lesson on the Physics of Flight, and what we've labeled a "Quest For" exercise. The Physics of Flight is a ~1+00 hour interactive lecture that equips the students or teacher participants with basic understanding of aircraft design and performance (lift, drag, etc.), stability, and control. The URL below will show the media used for this curriculum module.

This event is followed immediately by the Quest For exercise—which is essentially a ~1-2 hour guided tour of the major exhibits in the National Museum of the United States Air Force, in groups of 10-12 students—during which the guide relates the design features of the various aircraft to the design principles covered in the Physics of Flight session. The most effective Quest For exercise sessions involve the guide interactively quizzing the participants on a design feature—e.g., airfoil shape, wing sweep, tail and other control surface design, power plant type, and so forth—and having the students or teacher participants attempt to explain why the design is the way it is. The interaction is usually lively, and the learning robust. Lt Gen (ret) Dick Reynolds is requesting our support for the QFEs.

Of note, the 1015-1115 June 18th QFE session is set for 44 high school students, plus 30 Farnborough College of Technology students who will be on a Dayton sister city visit from Rushmoor in the United Kingdom. The QFE for the UK students will be extended to 2 hours. Please let me know by return email or text message (937-313-4735) if you can help out again this year—and the date(s) you're available. I'll email you a completed schedule in a month or so.
